

## Student Rules and Regulations Committee

Proposal to Revise Rules

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(Additions to rules are bolded and underlined, deletions to rules are indicated by strikethrough)

### **EXISTING RULE:**

12.6.3 The undergraduate student shall be informed of the terms of his or her probation and may be required by the dean of his or her college to register for a prescribed schedule of courses. Hour and grade point requirements shall be made consistent with the student's progress toward graduation. The specified hour and grade points are considered to be a minimum only.

### **RULE WITH PROPOSED CHANGES:**

12.6.3 The undergraduate student shall be informed **in writing, by letter and/or email**, of the terms of his or her probation and may be required by the dean of his or her college to register for a prescribed schedule of courses. Hour and grade point requirements shall be made consistent with the student's progress toward graduation. The specified hour and grade points are considered to be a minimum only.

### **JUSTIFICATION FOR PROPOSED CHANGE:**

This will make it clear for the students (and for advisors) that students must be sent a letter and/or email informing them they are on probation.
